IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES

Dear Delegate

Thank you for opting to attend our International Multi-Sport Coaching Conference at the City West on Sat 25th July. We are looking forward to seeing you all. We have an impressive line up of speakers and presenters from a wide range of sporting backgrounds and we hope that you will benefit from this wonderful Multi-Sport experience.

Arrival

On the day when you arrive, you will be asked to complete a registration card.

Registration

You will present this card with our ticket to one of the registration desks. There you will be given a conference tag, timetable and site map.

Conference Auditorium

After registration delegates can proceed to the main conference centre to visit our exhibition arena. Exhibition stands are located on the way to the auditorium and around the auditorium itself.

Crowding the Registration area must be avoided and we ask delegates to follow the instructions of our security staff.

The opening address and first keynote lecture will take place in the main auditorium – commencing at 09.30.

Important Information

Neither video cameras nor photographic devices will be allowed to be used at any stage other than the official designated conference cameramen and photographers.

Teas/Coffees will be purchasable from the hotel staffed café stands just outside the main auditorium.

Lectures will start on time. It is up to delegates to be in attendance for the start of each presentation or workshop.

If a lecture or workshop is full, the doors to that facility will be closed and no entrance will be allowed. Giving options to us merely lets us know the choices delegates hope to make but only being seated on time can guarantee a place at any given lecture.

People do not have to stick with any option given on the site. Each delegate is free to choose on the day which lecture they wish to attend providing there is room at the particular lecture.

If a lecture is full, delegates will be expected to select another presentation.

Lunch break

There is a lunch break of 60 minutes at 13.00 and the hotel will have a selection of two dinners available for delegates. These will be priced at 10.00 and 15.00 Euros respectively.
